"The war decides who is power, not who is right" - Bertrand Russell. In fact, it would not be wrong to use this definition for the endless Kashmir problem between India and Pakistan. After the UK withdrew from South Asia in 1947, it replaced small statists and princes in their heads. Although the United Kingdom appointed these princes, the princes were generally indigenous peoples. After the UK withdrew, it left Pakistan and India as two independent states, giving the princes the freedom to join the state of their choice. These clashes started from then. Although the princes generally took steps according to the population of the statists, this rule could be broken. At this time, clashes began to emerge between the two states. Such a conflict broke out about Kashmir and turned to war slowly. Now that war has turned into an endless crisis. The Kashmir issue, which was brought to the UN agenda at some times, is still unresolved due to the reluctance of the Indian side and being stronger than Pakistan. India has dictated to Pakistan what it wants since it has become a stronger party since the day of the crisis. Most recently, this issue flared up between the two states in February 2019, and relations were strained. The article addresses this crisis from day one to the present. Starting from the first part, it describes how conflict, war and crisis emerged.
