2.2. Term paper

Term paper (TP) on the subject is performing in the fifth semester according to approved in established order methodical guidelines to deepen theoretical knowledge and skills, acquired by the student in a process of learning educational material on the subject in the area of international economic relations using skills of individual and independent work using a variety of sources.

Specific aim of TP contains in deep and full disclosure of the contents of the relevant topics of the term paper, its most important issues using economic analysis tools to conduct research, the program of which is provided in guidelines on term paper design.

In order to attain a success in performing term paper student has to **know** general regularities of the world economy development, forms of these patterns in different sectors and regions, integration associations and specific countries; basic mechanisms of regulation and management of international economic relations development at the national, international and supranational levels; **be able** to formulate own views concerning unresolved problems in international economic relations and justify conclusions and proposals to solve them; analyze independently dynamic qualitative changes in the development of international economic relations; assess the current international economic events; characterize the current state, problems and prospects of Ukraine's participation in the global economy.

Time needed to perform TP is up to 30 hours of self-study.
