з самостійної роботи студентів з опанування навчального матеріалу з навчальної дисципліни «Лінгвокраїнознавство Сполучених Штатів Америки»

Самостійна робота студента є основним видом засвоєння навчального матеріалу у вільний від аудиторних занять час. Зміст СРС з конкретної дисципліни визначається робочою навчальною програмою з цієї дисципліни, навчально-методичними матеріалами, завданнями та вказівками викладача.

З навчальної дисципліни «Лінгвокраїнознавство Сполучених Штатів Америки» самостійна робота студентів передбачає:

- опанування лекційного матеріалу;
- самостійне вивчення теоретичних питань програми, що винесені на самостійне вивчення;
- робота з рекомендованими відеоматеріалами з тематики дисципліни;
- підготовку презентації у застосунку Power Point із обраної теми;
- підготовку до написання поточних тестів та модульної контрольної роботи.

Теоретичні питання, що винесені на самостійне вивчення:

Самостійна робота студентів спрямована на подальше формування лінгвокультурологічної компетенції, розвиток та розширення світогляду студентів у культурологічному аспекті, збагачення словникового запасу студента, розвиток навичок правильного структурного оформлення усного та писемного мовлення.
