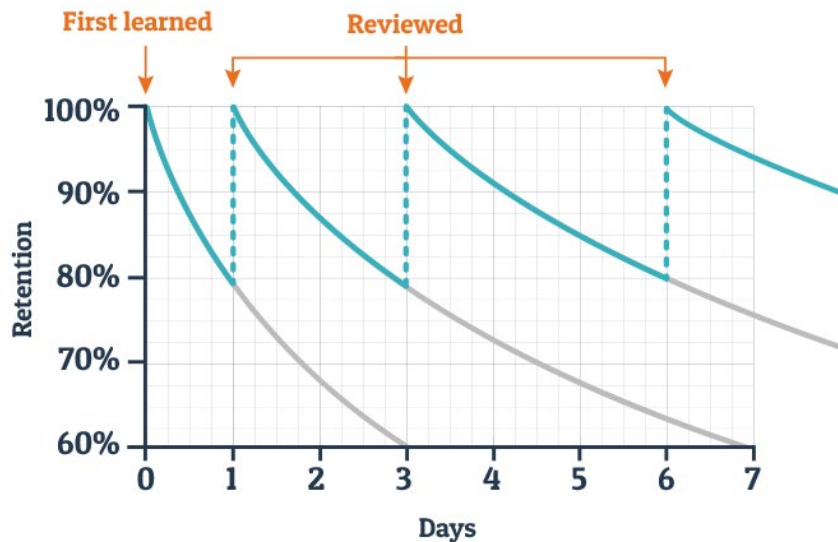


Fig.1 Typical Forgetting Curve for Newly Learned Information.
